### Attendance Procedures

A parent or guardian must call and report a student's absence by 9:00am on the same day the student is absent. The student must also bring a note from home upon returning to school. An absence is considered unexcused until there is a written note or email received from home.

- a. The note should include the date(s) of absence, the specific reason for the absence, and a signature of either parent or legal guardian.
- b. A note simply explaining the absence will not excuse the absence.

The reason determines whether the absence is excused or unexcused.

In grades 9-12, a student who misses a class more than 10 times per year may have his grade lowered one third letter grade or may not receive credit for the class unless an extended illness is involved. In grades 9-12, all absences after the ninth in a year will require a written doctor's excuse in order to be considered excused.
